PARADE RULES

Improper use of the American flag will not be permitted

- All entries must be received by 5:00 PM Friday, October 19, 2018, to participate in the 98th Veterans Day Parade. All entry fees must be paid in full before entries are admitted to final line-up.
- The parade application must be returned 100% complete to be considered. The Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse any entries. The entry described on your application is the only entry that will be allowed into the parade.
- Each unit entering the parade must have a patriotic motif. All signs must be stenciled in red, white, and blue.
- Entries must observe all applicable regulations and requirements or be barred from the parade. Only Patriotic music may be played from vehicles in the parade. Vehicle doors must remain closed at all times during the parade. The Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade-prior to staging in the staging area or any time during the parade. Any entrant not conforming to the regulations and requirements or any entrant refusing to follow instructions of the police or parade officials will be removed from the parade. All units must either be preceded by a patriotic type banner identifying the unit, club, float, etc. or have a sign or banner attached to the float or vehicle identifying the unit club, float etc.
- All entries must be able to maintain their speed and position throughout the parade. Maneuvering, sidestepping, counter-marching, stopping or any other actions delaying the progress of parade or creating large gaps along the parade route are prohibited. Distance between parade entries should be kept at 30 feet. For safety reasons: No Burnouts are Allowed; ALL vehicle doors must remain closed at all times during the parade.
- Any dispute may be presented to the Parade Committee
- The Parade Committee reserves the right to set a maximum number of entries per category and a maximum number of participants per entry. Walkers, beside or in front of an entry, for safety purposes are not considered additional participants.

• NOTHING MAY BE THROWN IN FRONT OF THE REVIEWING STAND.

Those planning entries should remember that the audience is largely made up of Veterans, children and their families. The goal for the event is to honor our Veterans, Active Duty personnel and our Nation while making it a great family fun day.
